SUMMARY JUDGMENT KINDLY REQUESTED

1. Introduction

Plaintiff Robert Viragh is a divorced, 43-year-old AI entrepreneur and contractor holding United States and Hungarian citizenship who uses AI professionally and recreationally.

2. Background

After discovering an online community of tickling enthusiasts (an adult hobby) that he found appealing and wished to join, he observed bruises on the images he produced with AI adjacent to this subject.

3. Remedy

Plaintiff respectfully requests a summary judgment requesting that FBI and its agents, proxies, and partners, get to the bottom of this so that inappropriate bruises do not appear when generating consensual adult content using AI, under **28 U.S.C. § 1361. Action to compel an officer of the United States to perform his duty** which reads:

“The district courts shall have original jurisdiction of any action in the nature of mandamus to compel an officer or employee of the United States or any agency thereof to perform a duty owed to the plaintiff.”

It is requested that summary judgment be made electronically to avoid extra burden to the Bureau or travel costs to me (I live in Budapest, Hungary), or, if a hearing is required, an electronic video meeting is requested due to travel costs. (I've submitted a request for waiver of the court costs.)
